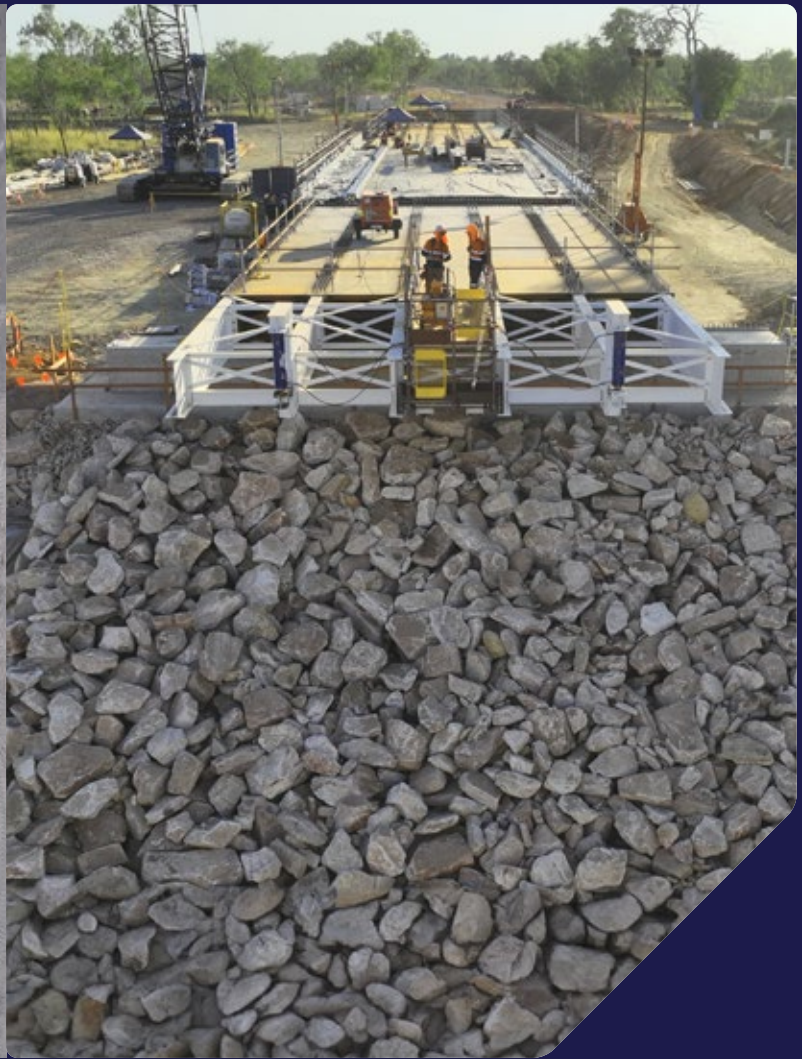

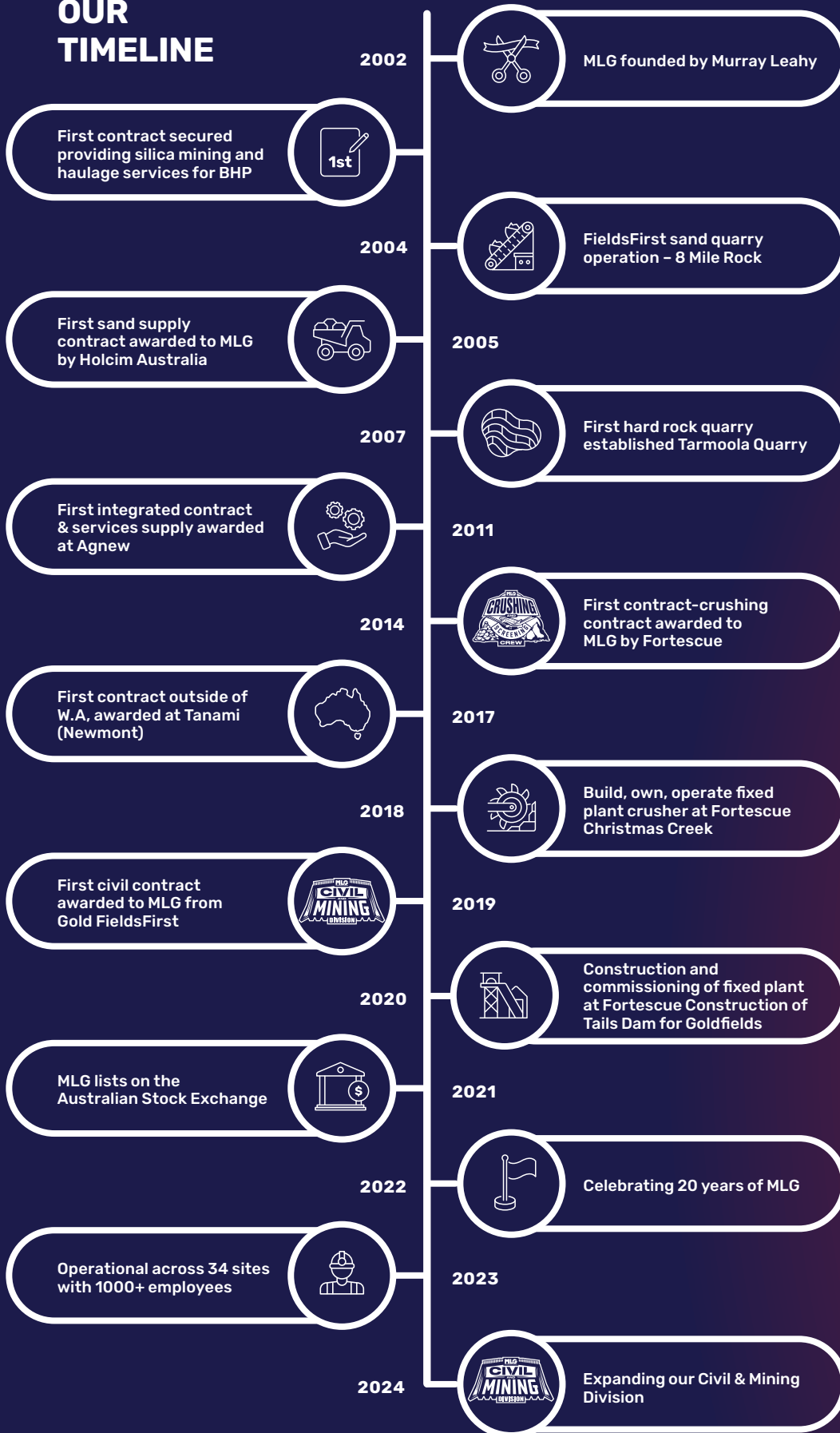
CRUSHING & SCREENING

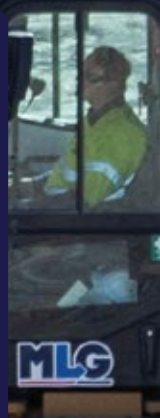

JUNDEE MINE SITE

KNOWN FOR ITS RICH GOLD DEPOSITS, THE JUNDEE OPERATIONS ARE STRATEGICALLY LOCATED WITHIN THE YANDAL GREENSTONE BELT, NORTHEAST OF WILUNA. JUNDEE HAS BEEN A CONSISTENT GOLD PRODUCER SINCE ITS FIRST PRODUCTION IN 1995.

The Jundee Operations include both open-pit and underground mining activities. Gold ore is sourced from the primary Jundee underground mine, supplemented by the Ramone underground site and the Julius open pit. MLG's role at Jundee centres around efficient, large-scale ore haulage critical to sustaining Jundee's high-grade, narrow-vein gold production. With MLG's expertise in bulk haulage and logistics, ore transport from Ramone to the processing plant is seamless, supporting a smooth workflow and consistent output.

The Jundee underground mine, accessed through multiple portals and spans extensive mining developments, benefits from MLG's dedicated fleet and supply chain solutions, ensuring uninterrupted ore flow. This enables Northern Star to maintain its conventional CIL (Carbon-in-Leach) processing plant's capacity, which can process approximately 3 million tonnes of ore annually.

MLG's partnership in this project exemplifies its commitment to delivering reliable and tailored services in demanding mining environments. By aligning with Jundee's safety and operational standards, MLG supports Northern Star's goal of sustainable, efficient production, helping meet global demand for gold. Located in the regional town of Westonia, approximately 320 km east of Perth, the Edna May site operates within a predominantly farming region, providing unique logistical and operational challenges.

A notable achievement for this project is MLG’s successful acquisition of permits to operate PBS triple road trains—the first granted in the region. These high-capacity vehicles enable MLG to transport larger loads with fewer trips, enhancing efficiency and road safety.

Additionally, MLG is responsible for maintaining 70 km of unsealed public roads critical to the Marda haulage route. The road maintenance operation includes grading and extensive dust suppression to ensure safe and accessible routes. This involves using a grader supported by a semi-water cart and a 76,000-litre road train water cart dedicated to dust control on the unsealed road section.



ST IVES GOLD MINE

SINCE 2017, MLG HAS SUPPORTED ST IVES GOLD MINE WITH BULK HAULAGE AND SITE SERVICES, MOVING 5.4 MILLION TONNES OF GOLD ORE AND 1.4 MILLION TONNES OF TAILINGS ANNUALLY. ADDITIONAL SERVICES INCLUDE ROAD MAINTENANCE, REHABILITATION EARTHWORKS, AND CRUSHER FEED OPERATIONS. WITH A \$48 MILLION CONTRACT VALUE, MLG DELIVERS EFFICIENT, SUSTAINABLE, AND HIGH-QUALITY MINING SUPPORT TO ONE OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA'S LARGEST GOLD MINES.

The project spans a broad scope of services to optimise productivity and site infrastructure, establishing MLG as a cornerstone of the operation since 2017. Our role encompasses off-road haulage of gold ore, a highly specialised task, managed with a fleet of 988K and WA600 loaders that feeds our fleet of 300 Tonne Mack Titans trailed by a set of triple Mick Murray Welding built trailers.

By transporting 5.4 million tonnes of gold ore annually, MLG has built a reputation for efficient material handling, ensuring seamless ore movement from mine to mill. Additionally, MLG harvests and screens Tailings material and hauls 1.4 million tonnes of this by-product to help secure environmental compliance while maximising material utility.

Rehabilitation earthworks are vital to our responsibility, emphasising land restoration and sustainable operations across the mine site. Our D8 and D9 dozers and our fleet of excavators ranging from 36 tonnes to 120 tonnes play critical roles in these tasks, supporting earthworks and causeway construction to improve mine accessibility and mitigate environmental impact.

Crusher feed and float work services add further depth to MLG's offering, underscoring our versatile capabilities in mine site logistics. With a contract value of \$48 million to date, MLG's ongoing work at St Ives Gold Mine reflects our commitment to delivering high-quality, efficient, and responsible services tailored to our clients' needs.
